

# Summer School in High Energy Processing Ultrasound & Microwave technologies Université d'Avignon, France 6-10 June 2011

- Four day event aimed at postgraduate students and Post-doc researchers with an interest in expanding their knowledge in ultrasound and microwaves technologies applied to chemical processes (Sonochemistry, Microwaves, Green technologies, Environmental processing, Synthesis, Extraction). The course will include both theoretical and practical classes.
- The microwave sessions will be lead by Prof Gary Bond who has over 20 years experience of applying microwaves to chemical systems. The microwave course will start by introducing students to the interaction of microwaves with matter and use this understanding to address fundamental issues relating to the design of microwave based experiments. While it is outside the scope of this course to cover the fundamentals of microwave applicator design students will be introduced to a range of applicators that can be used / modified for chemicals synthesis / processing.
  A review of current applications of microwaves in the areas of organic synthesis, polymer processing, catalysis and materials characterisation will be provided. This will cumulate in a session devoted to looking at industrial scale microwave processes for chemicals production and processing.
- The ultrasound techniques will be covered by Prof Tim Mason and Dr. Eadaoin Joyce who are both internationally recognised for their work in the application of ultra sound to chemical systems.
- The summer school is limited to **50 participants**. All coffee and lunches will be provided by the organising committee.
- Registration fee for the Summer School is €100 (cash) which can be paid at registration. Transportation to and from ICMS is included.
- Three Scholarship of 400.00 Euro/each will be offered to AMPERE young members who will present proper request to AMPERE Secretariat (see website www.ampereeurope.org)
- A formal conference dinner will be arranged for 8<sup>th</sup> June 2011. This can be paid for at the point of registration.
- There will be a poster session for participants on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> April 2011 during the visit of ICSM Centre de Marcoule. If you wish to present a poster please prepare to **size A0** (Height x Width 1189 x 841 mm or 46.8 x 33.1 inches) and email the title of the poster to Dr E. Joyce (e.joyce@coventry.ac.uk) by the **16<sup>th</sup> May 2011**.
- **Travel:** UK direct flights to Avignon or Marseille (+ TGV to Avignon, Paris is only 2h40)
