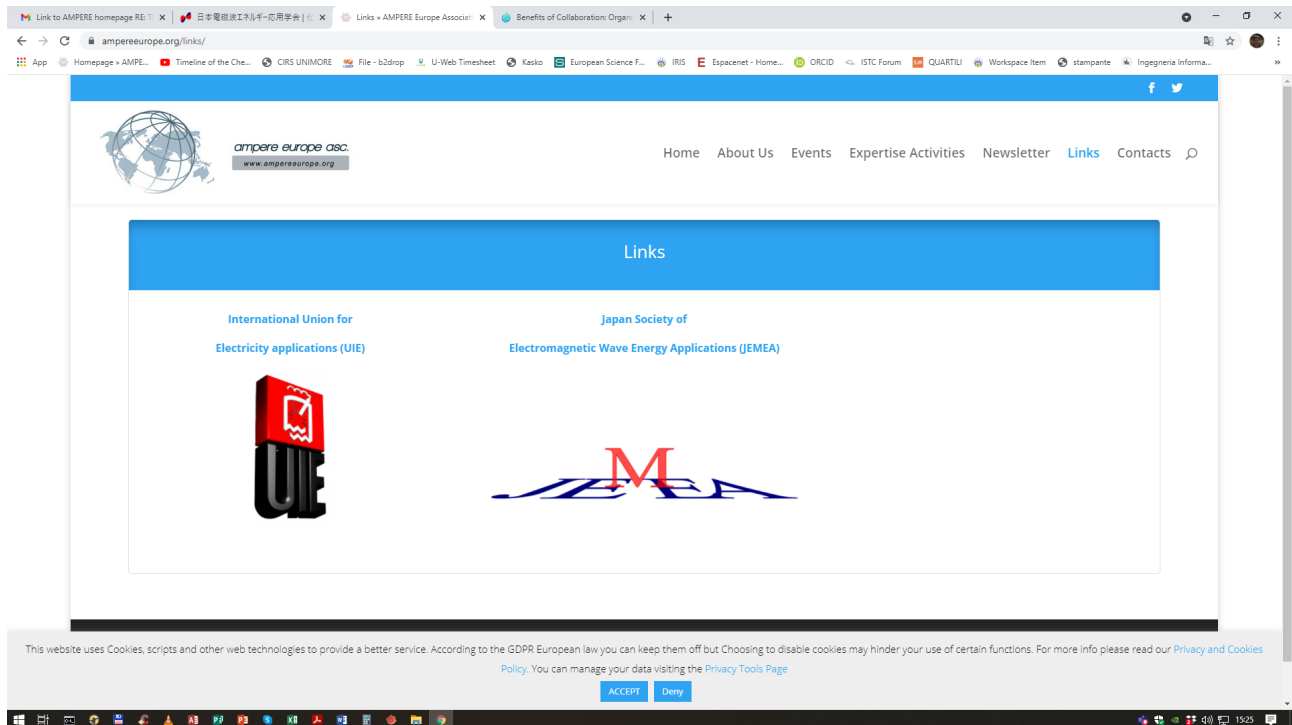


## Benefits of Collaboration Between Organizations: new links to UIE and JEMEA webpages
