## 2- Abstract submission procedure

An abstract for the AMPERE 2025 conference is subject to an Editorial Processing Charge (EPC). The organisers have decided to waive the EPC, but the author must "buy" the abstract through the Shop Area. # Abstracts will be published in Scientific Research Abstracts (ISSN 2464-9147).

Please note that each abstract will be uploaded by the presenter in a new website geometry that has been implemented to facilitate the elaboration of:

- The book of abstracts;
- The conference programme;
- The list of participants.

Abstract submission will be closed on 7 March 2025.

## 3- Registration fees and payment

Early Bird Registration Fees have been offered to those who may choose to pay before 6 May 2025. Payment will be made online via a special access. To access to the Shop Area (<a href="https://ampere.absmanager.com/account/">https://ampere.absmanager.com/account/</a>), the author should have an account and be logged in (<a href="https://ampere.absmanager.com/registration/">https://ampere.absmanager.com/registration/</a>).

As a consequence of point 2, all the presenters of Oral or Poster contributions should pay their own Registration Fee before **11 July 2025**. At this date the FINAL PROGRAMME and the BOOK OF ABSTRACTS will be prepared.

If a presenter does not respect the deadline of 11 July, his/her contribution will be deleted from the FINAL PROGRAMME and the BOOK OF ABSTRACTS.

## 4- Publication options

The highest quality submissions will be invited to provide a full article, to be published in the new journal from AMPERE, the 'European Journal of Microwave Energy—EJME' (e-ISSN: 2753-3921) (https://ejme.cardiffuniversitypress.org/).

In addition to this option, we also offer the submission an extended abstract (max 6 pages), which will be published in in ProScience (ISSN: 2283-5954), an Open Access Conference Proceedings series. A registered author may submit, free of charge, a maximum of 1 extended abstract. For additional extended abstracts, a publication fee (Euro 250.00) has to be paid for each contribution.

Extended abstract submission will be closed on **31 October 2025**.
